The country in celebration

## Kaupelan Welcomes its Heroes



Shaoran. “The organisation of the Games was flawless, and the organising committee did a really good job. In my opinion, the format of the Games is ideal for small countries like those of FICT, having more individual sports and less team sports”, said the former football player. Mi Senderehe added that the safety during the event was total, referring to the menace of a terrorist attack that was completely avoided by the Maysorian police, a few months ago.

A crowd was waiting for the athletes at the international airport of Kotamakuwa, on arrival last night. The delegation will be received at Watera Stadium today at 10:00AM by Their Majesties King Kira II and Queen Saramdi. The stadium must be full for greeting the national heroes.

With the celebration, the disappointment with the poor performance of the men’s football team was forgotten. Once again, the national team was eliminated in the first phase of the competition, despite coach Peter Sutumadan’s effort to restructure the team. The team lost only one game and was eliminated by Adzhatia, like in 2017. And Adzhatia maintained its hegemony in all FICT Games, gaining three out of four gold medals of men’s football.

**Bizet** - From the feet of the right back Tjemnin Porto, started the victory against Voskia, 2-0, in the final of women’s football of FICT Games 2019, disputed in Bizet, the capital of the Republic of MAS. With this gold medal, Kaupelan became the winner of the Games, followed by Harrawi, Adzhatia and Voskia. It was the first conquest of Kaupelan since the creation of the Games in 2013. The result puts Kaupelan in the second place in the overall table of medals.

The extraordinary campaign surpassed even the most optimistic predictions. From a mere sixth place in 2017, disputed at home, the Kaupelanes team positively surprised with a brilliant performance: gold medals in women’s football, men’s sailing, with Singa Wisnuwarsa, and men’s cycling, with Yafet Ulwayatu; silver medals in women’s triathlon, with Betsina Mahera, and men’s athletics (100m), with Ngaru Wahid; and bronze medal in women’s athletics (400m), with Mawar Wainot. It was the second consecutive gold medal of Singa Wisnuwarsa in laser modality, becoming a promise for the Olympic Games in Tokyo, in 2020.

Ramiru Senderehe, president of the Kaupelanes Olympic Committee, praised the entire delegation and the organisation of the Games by the Republic of Maysoran, Algheran and
